

Northumbria University - Bachelor of Science Nursing Inaugural Intake Grant

Terms and Conditions

- The S\$1,500 inaugural intake grant extended by Northumbria University is open to students pursuing a Bachelor of Science Nursing (Top-up) programme (part-time) offered by Kaplan Higher Education Institute.
- Valid only for the first 50 students who enrol in the programme before 25 January 2023, for the inaugural intake which commences on 25 January 2023. An “enrolment” is an application for a programme where the application fee has been paid.
- To qualify, students have to meet the requirements of the programme and in all cases, the final decision on admission to the programme rests with the University.
- Students awarded (the “awardees”) must pay the programme fee according to the applicable instalment payment schedule. The S\$1,500 inaugural intake grant will be automatically deducted from the student’s last fee instalment for the programme.
- Any applicable Goods and Services Tax (GST) will remain chargeable at the prevailing rate on the full gross fee. Awardees will be required to pay the full sum of applicable GST.
- The grant will be forfeited if the awardee withdraws from, defers or fails to complete the programme.
- If the grant is forfeited for any reason, the awardee will not be eligible for any further subsequent award of the grant.
- Kaplan, on behalf of Northumbria University, reserves the right to withdraw and/or revoke the grant if the awardee breaches or is subsequently found to have breached any applicable law, does not exemplify conduct or performance (whether academic or others) of a deserving student and/or any disciplinary action is taken against the awardee.

- Not applicable to International students.
